Summer 2019

The Bosnian Advocacy Center has consistently appeared in leading international and domestic media outlets.

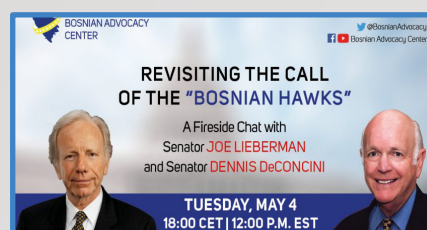
We provided commentary on current political events and appeared in media as part of an ongoing BAC campaign.



MEETINGS AND INITIATIVES

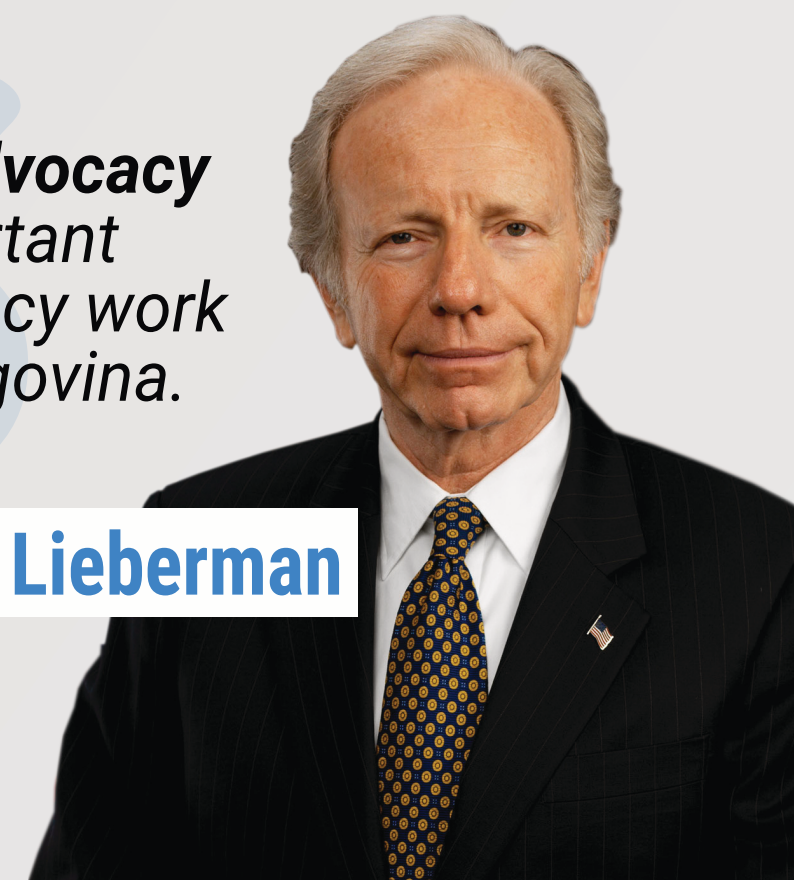
